## **Expectations of coaches in G.M.A.A.**

**The Coach:** must instill the qualities of good sportsmanship and fair play in his/her athletes. Athletes must be taught good sportsmanship and what it means.

**The Coach:** must teach and set the example of respect towards the officials, players of both teams and spectators at all times.
